## Family Pledge: I will...

- ✓ Let the teacher know if my child has any problems with learning.
- ✓ Use reading and math materials the school sends home each week to help my child.
- ✓ Read with my child everyday as instructed by my child's teacher.
- ✓ Help my child see how to use reading and math to pursue his/her interests and goals.
- ✓ Assure that my child gets **8-10 hours** of rest a night.
- ✓ Assure my child attends school regularly.
- ✓ Provide an area for my child to complete homework without distractions.

- ✓ If your child is absent from school, please send a note with the child's name, date of absence and reason for absence. This will allow us to excuse most absences.

- ✓ Grade assignments promptly and send papers home in a timely manner.
- ✓ Monitor student progress and update parents every 6 weeks.

- ✓ Explain our approach to teaching, grade level expectations, and classroom grading system to students and their families.
